By means of this programme, the two foundations and partner institutions want to strengthen the "European dimension" in the thinking of young people on whose decisions the future shape of Europe is likely to depend. Apart from studying at one of the universities in Berlin or Brandenburg, the participants attend lectures and seminars. We would be pleased to receive their applications for the next academic year which will start in September 2013 and end in July 2014. Fellows of the programme will receive a monthly scholarship of EUR 800 as well as lump sum of EUR 1.000 for their travel expenses.

current academic student (of any discipline) completion of basic studies (in at the least third year of study in one discipline, no Ph.D. students) up to 28 years old excellent academic achievements strong interest in European issues ability to work in a team and willingness to do intensive project work all candidates have to apply independently for a place at a university in Berlin or Brandenburg
