After attending Thomas Aquinas College and The Catholic University of America (Ph.D.), Dr. Kwasniewski taught courses in natural philosophy, metaphysics, moral theology, Catholic social doctrine, fundamental and biblical theology, Christology and ecclesiology, and sacraments and liturgy at the International Theological Institute in Gaming, Austria, from 1998 to 2006. During this period he also lectured on medieval philosophy for the Austrian Program of Ave Maria University, on human rights for the Phoenix Institute Europe Foundation, and on music history for the Austrian Program of the Franciscan University of Steubenville.

His articles on philosophy, theology, and music have appeared in journals such as *The Thomist*, *Communio*, *Nova & Vetera*, *Mediaeval Studies*, *Modern Schoolman*, *Doctor Angelicus*, *The Downside Review*, *Angelicum*, *Faith & Reason*, *Logos*, and *The Aquinas Review*. He has published two books with The Catholic University of America Press, one as editor, the other as co-translator: *Wisdom's Apprentice: Essays in Honor of Fr. Lawrence Dewan, O.P.* and *On Love and Charity: Readings from the Sentences Commentary of St. Thomas Aquinas*.

Dr. Kwasniewski is Professor of Theology and Philosophy, Instructor in Music History and Theory, and Founding Choirmaster at Wyoming Catholic College in Lander. He is also a published and performed composer, especially of sacred music.
